FIRE SAFETY REGULATIONS

New state fire regulations require **ALL** productions contact the fire department in each city/town in which your production will be prepping and/or filming. For more information, please contact the appropriate fire department contact listed <u>here</u>. *

*Please make sure your production office, locations and special effects departments are informed of this.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

As of July 1, 2018, the new Hot Work regulations for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts will be in effect. Hot Work Certification with the City of Boston will be accepted by the Commonwealth of MA and there will be no need to retake the course.

*Welding and allied processes, heat treating, grinding, thawing pipes, powder-driven fasteners, hot riveting, torch-applied roofing and any similar applications producing or using sparks, flame or heat.
